WEBSITE TUTORIALS

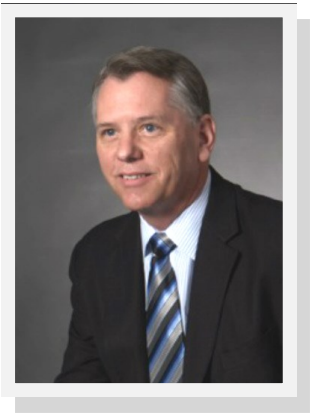
