Good News Clubs

On Tuesday, June 17th, I held a one day DVD Training for new volunteers. There were 11 in attendance. Most of these new volunteers attend the Mims Methodist church and will be working with the children from the Mims Elementary Good News Club.

We are in discussions with the Principal of Mims Elementary about bringing the Good News Club (GNC) over to the Mims Methodist Church instead of holding it in the school. The church is one block from the school and the Principal is supportive of this change. Many details have to be worked out, but we hope to have the Club begin meeting in the church in October 2014. CEF is also supportive of this move.

We also received good news from the Principal at Pinewood Elementary that she would like to have a Good News Club in her school as soon as we can raise up volunteers. Our plans now are to have this Club begin in January 2015.

There is an urgent need for new volunteers in all the Clubs as some of our volunteers have already indicated that they will not be continuing in the fall. If you love children, we would love to have you join us next October.

We are looking forward to seeing what God will do to reach the children in the years ahead in our community.
