

Casey's aim is to bring hope to desperate women who live in cultures where there seems to be no way out. She plans to spend her life counselling and disciplining girls in their relationship with God, to strengthen and embolden them, and teach them sound biblical truth about their identity in Christ and the purposeful lives he has created

HOPE FOR KIDS MEXICO - Miguel Aleman is a small city just across the border from Roma, TX, and is best known for drug trafficking and poverty. In 2007 two Mexican pastors there began a school in their church with 55 students. It is the only school in their city to focus on the Bible and on teaching English. Christians from Michigan organized Hope for Kids to help them build their own school, Eagle College. ("Colegio" means "school" in Spanish.) It opened in 2014 with 180 students from Preschool
